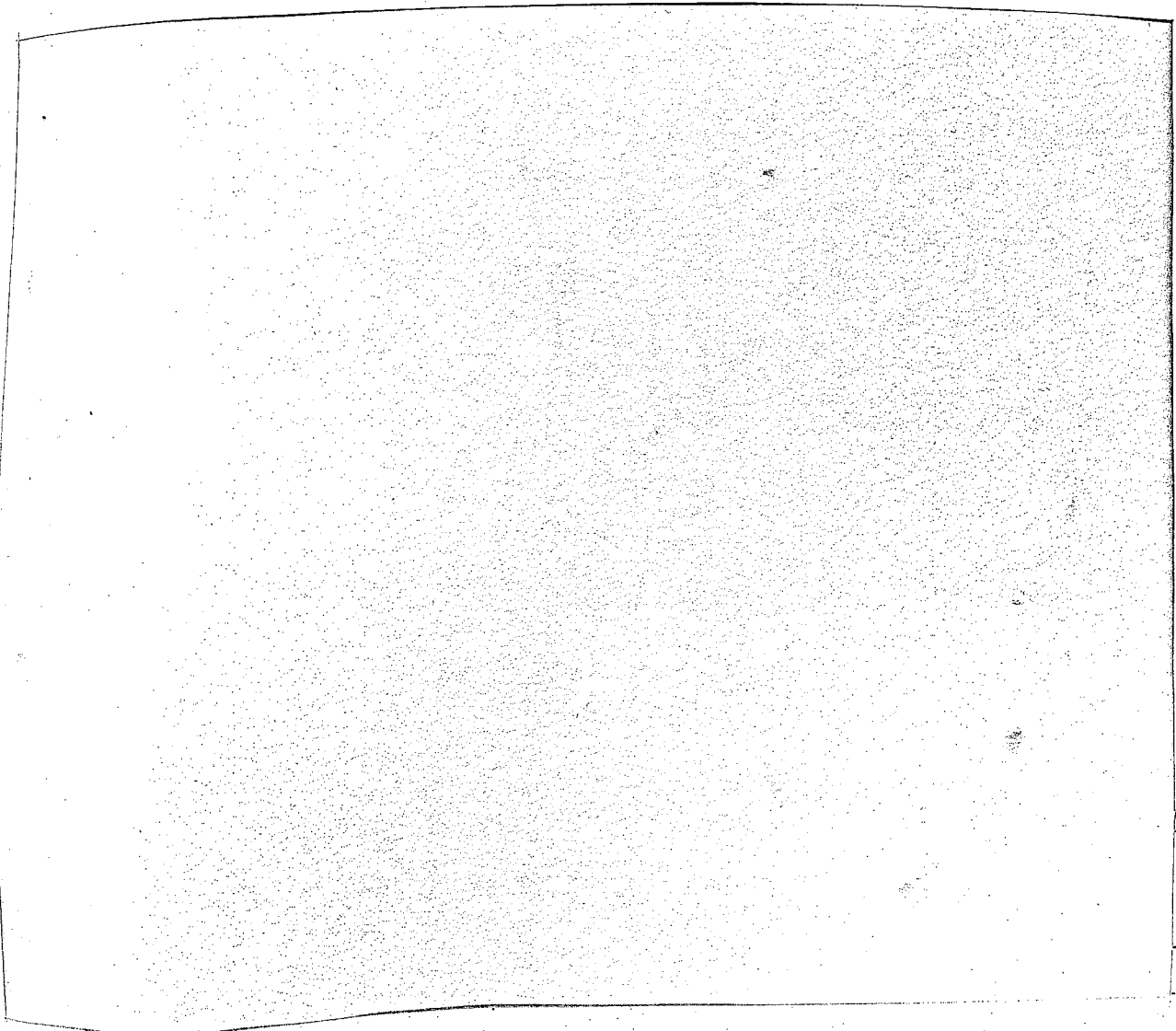

Increased Efforts to Combat Terrorism

6. On 23 January 2002 the Ad Hoc Cabinet Committee on Intelligence and Security agreed a budget bid should be submitted by the NZSIS as part of improving New Zealand's capabilities to counter terrorism². The NZSIS bid is as follows:

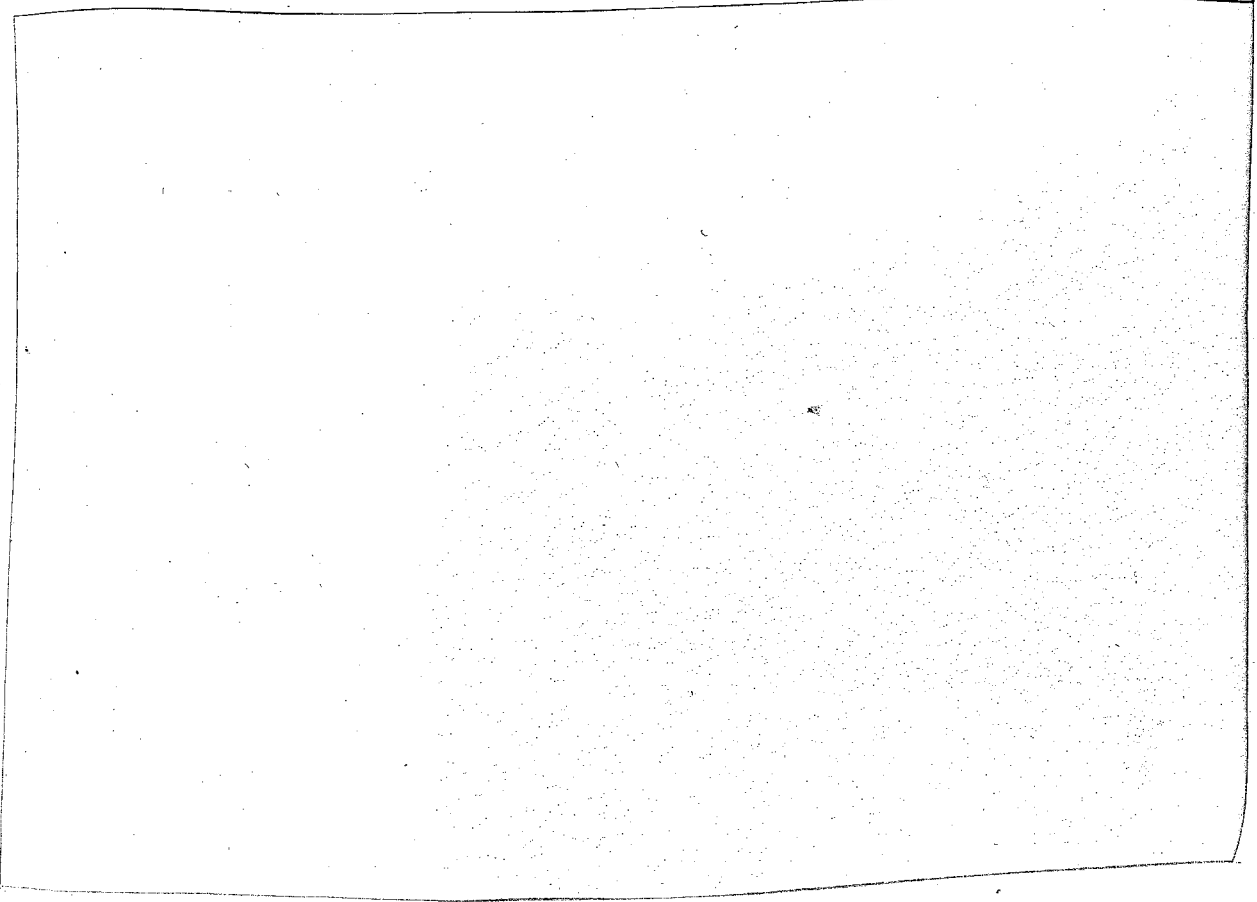

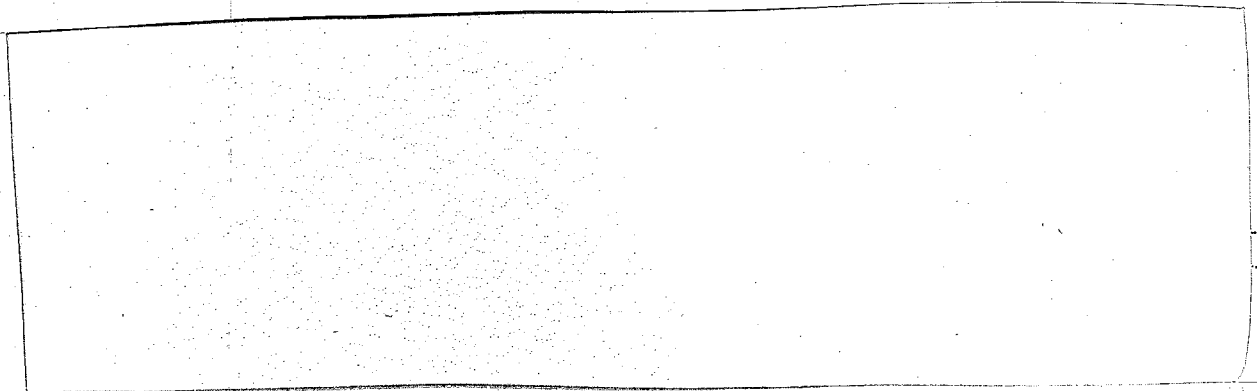

Treasury Comment

19. The New Zealand Security Intelligence Service underwent a baseline review in 2000 to place the Service on a sustainable budget footing. At this time it was agreed that no further funding would be sought until 2003/04 except in exceptional circumstances. Since that time the Service has received agreement to a substantial funding increase to meet the costs of additional counter terrorist tasks (an increase in the existing budget of approximately 40%).
