I respectfully report that W. HEINE of 9 Volcanic St, Mt Eden, Auckland whose name appears on the guest list for the German Club, Auckland is a tailor in business at 40 Security Edgs, Queen St, Auckland.

I have ascertained by a personal interview and also from information received that this man is not identical and is not connected with the barrister of the same name at Wellington.

W. Heine, of Auckland is a man about 55 years of age, about 5 ft 3 ins in height and he has been in New Zealand about 30 years and has been a naturalised British subject for a great many years.

He has heard that there is a barrister in Wellington of the same name but that is all he knows about him.

Please ascertain whether W. Heine, Barrister of Wellington, is identical or connected with the person of that name appearing on the guest list of the German Club, Auckland. If so I would like a report submitted regarding his antecedents and what is known of him.

The Navy Office, Wellington, are impressed by the fact that the German Consul, Dr Hellenthal, and Mr W. Heine, Barrister and Solicitor, each has separately asked to be shown through the Navy Office with a view to renting the rooms when vacated shortly by the Navy Office, it being considered that as far as Dr Hellenthal at least was concerned he has no genuine interest in the renting of those rooms, but nothing is known of Mr Heine.
