relative to German activities in Auckland.

"Vide attached Memo"

I respectfully report that I have informed [redacted] in terms of the attached memo (para.1).

Concerning para 2 a press report states that the German Consul Herr Ramm has been handed his papers to leave New Zealand.. Should it be known that his port of departure is Auckland I would suggest that I be advised in order that his movements may be watched as he would probably meet Kurt Wilhelm Schmidt or other known Nazis here.

The smoke concert for Germans and Italians, referred to in my report of 9/8/39 is now definitely abandoned.

The matter referred to in para 3 is being dealt with in a separate file as instructed.

REPORT of Detective E.A. Stevenson, No. 2627

relative to report re German Club activities.

I respectfully report that on the 8 th inst., I received the following report from the Department's informant within the German Club.

"There has not been much political activity within the Club lately and only one new German member has joined. His name is Wild and he travels for a German Chemical Firm. Further particulars later. The German Consul will visit Auckland about the 12 th of this month and will be entertained by the Club. I will report anything that happens. The Stutzpunkt are giving a Smoking Concert in the near future to Germans, German-speaking friends and the Italian Club. This is something new but as I expect to be invited I will be able to report on it."

I made inquiries of the Customs Dept. regarding Wild... It seems that he is most probably identical with KASPAR WILD, who arrived in Auckland from Sydney by the "Niagara" on 23/1/39... He is shown as German nationality, born in Rome on 4/10/1912. He is single and is employed by Schering Proprietary Ltd, Wellington... The particulars given say that this firm are medical retailers.

Concerning the proposed smoke concert it may be of some little significance that the Stutzpunkt itself - and not the German Club itself - are giving this function.... As far as I know this is the first time that the Stutzpunkt has in any way come into the open.
